WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

Mentee Eligibility:



- Must be a person with a disability
- Must agree to devote 2 hours per month
- Must complete a meet + greet call
- Have a goal for the experience
- Attendance at DRR events is encouraged

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

Mentor Eligibility:

- Must be a leader in the disability community
- Must commit to mentor for a 12-month period
- Must agree to devote at least 2 hours per month
- Must complete meet + greet call
- A background check will be conducted

HOW ARE MENTORING MATCHES MADE?

Matches are made on a quarterly basis

- Matches made based on electronic app + matching procedures
- Each partnership is confirmed by Disability Rights & Resources
- Staff will review partners' applications to ensure they will be a good fit

HOW MUCH TIME WILL THIS TAKE?

Your Time Commitment:

- Partnerships are actively supported by Disability Rights & Resources for 12 months
- Participants may choose to continue their relationship beyond the staff-supported time frame

HOW WILL I COMMUNICATE WITH MY PARTNER?

Communication may be:



- By phone
- By email
- By web meeting
- Other forms of communication at the discretion of both participants

WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW?

For Mentors and Mentees:



- All program applicants will sign a confidentiality statement
- Confidentiality is built into Disability Rights & Resources' Standard Operating Procedures
- All participants must adhere to all policies and procedures
